### Delegation – Wolf Kraft – Subdivision Proposal

Mr. Kraft was present to discuss his subdivision proposal for SP Lot 6, Plan 19580 – east of PR 504. Highlights of the discussion included:

- All proposed lots to be zoned for residential use no rezoning required
- Development Agreement to be drafted by RM
- Drainage / elevation plan for subdivided area will be required rock pit near Birch Haven intersection may be a suitable component of the drainage system
- Further residential development of residual parcel to the east Phase 2

### <u>Delegation – Brad & Donna Marr – Proposed Accessory Building</u>

Mr. & Mrs. Marr were present to discuss their proposal to build an accessory building (detached garage) on their vacant property north of Hampton Road. Highlights of the discussion included:

- Proposal to build detached garage on vacant lot / building to be larger than maximum allowable square footage
- Construction of an accessory building prior to the main dwelling is not permitted under the Planning Scheme
- Variance to build the garage and to exceed maximum square footage would be required before a building permit could be issued
- Council indicated concerns with varying the requirement to build a dwelling first suggested that owners should delay their plans until they are prepared to build a dwelling and include the detached garage as part of the application

# <u>Delegation – Rudy Isaak – Gibson/Bayview Drainage</u>

Mr. Isaak was present to discuss possible options relating to drainage concerns in the Gibson/Bayview area. Various alternatives were discussed, including:

- Restricting vehicular traffic in the immediate area
- Stone & culverts required to complete the project work
- Contractor would be required to perform most or all the work
- Rudy to provide specs for the project
